

# What's new for Hilleberg – 2024

## New Saivo 4, and reconfigured Saivo 3

Exceptionally strong and spacious 3- and 4-person dome tents built to handle the most demanding adventures in any weather and any season.



The new Saivo 4 is engineered to be the ultimate expedition dome tent. Part of our most robust all-season Black Label series, its extraordinary interior volume will comfortably accommodate four plus all their gear, while its two spacious vestibules – one standard sized and a larger one with an extra pole – offer even greater comfort and storage capability. Its pole system both creates multiple crossing points for exceptional strength to handle high winds and heavy snow loading and offers remarkably easy pitching,



even by one person in challenging conditions. Meanwhile, the three-person Saivo 3 – formerly just the Saivo – receives the same vestibule configuration update. Both models are outstanding choices for base camp or expedition use in any weather, any terrain and on any trip, from mountaineering or polar expeditions to desert treks or long paddling tours. And their strength and comfort are equally well-suited to less demanding adventures like family camping trips and summer base camp hiking forays.

## New Rogen 3

Wonderfully lightweight 2- and 3-person dome tents that are excellent choices for any kind of trip in snow-free conditions.



The two-person Yellow Label dome tent Rogen has long been a user favorite for its two vestibule/two entrance construction and its impressively light weight. 2024 sees the introduction of the new three-person Rogen 3, bringing a three-person dome tent option to the Yellow Label series of snow-free adventure tents and complementing the two-person Rogen 2, formerly called the Rogen. The Rogen models are excellent choices for any trip in warmer weather, from backpacking to paddling to bikepacking. Two vestibules offer comfort and plenty of gear storage, a short pole in the roof provides extra headroom, and both doors can be configured in multiple ways for extra flexibility. Both are remarkably strong, able to handle any rain and wind that



can crop up in the snow-free months, and with the curved patterning on the bottom of their outer tent walls and large, all-mesh panels on the inner tent doors, they offer excellent ventilation in both fine and foul weather. Both now have a guy line on each entrance and on the head and foot ends for both greater stability and even more air flow options. The new Rogen 3 adds another level of versatility to the Rogen "family": a solo traveler looking for extra comfort without much extra weight could easily choose the Rogen 2, and now a pair of adventurers have that same upsizing but still very light option with the Rogen 3.

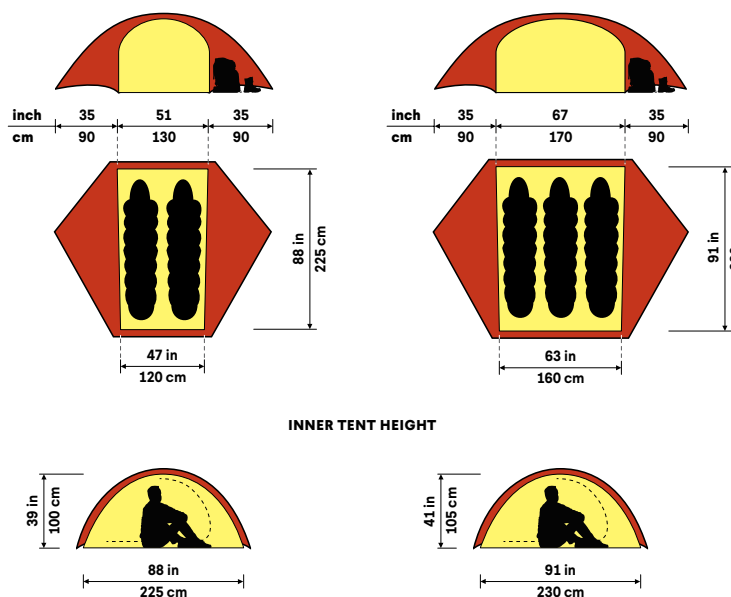

- » Kerlon 1000 outer tent fabric has an impressive 8 kg/17.5 lb tear strength, making for a very lightweight tent that still offers plenty of strength.
- » 9 mm poles – the same used in the all-season Red Label series – provide excellent strength while still being very light.
- » Linked inner and outer tents allow either simultaneous pitching or separate use for the greatest versatility.
- » Dome construction is fully self-supporting, requiring only the vestibules to be pegged out.
- » Pole system with two equal-length main crossing poles and continuous pole sleeves make pitching both simple and quick, even in tough pitching conditions.
- » Curved patterning on the bottom of the outer tent walls and all-mesh inner tent doors provide superb airflow.
- » Dual entrances/vestibules provide flexible entry/exit options, ample gear storage and more comfort.
- » The inner tent can be replaced with the optional Rogen Mesh Inner Tent.

- » 10 mm poles are built to handle extreme weather.
- » Linked inner and outer tents allow either simultaneous pitching or separate use for the greatest versatility.
- » Pole system creates multiple crossing points for impressive strength while offering simple pitching, even in tough pitching conditions.
- » Dome construction is fully self-supporting, requiring only the vestibules to be pegged out.
- » Outer tent walls go extend to the ground and all mesh areas are backed with adjustable fabric panels for maximum weather protection.
- » Multiple vents high up provide ventilation even if the tent is buried in snow or tall brush.
- » Dual entrances/vestibules provide flexible entry/exit options, ample gear storage and more comfort.
