


# WHAT'S NEW FOR 2018

#### **Mesh Tent 1**








The new Mesh Tent 1 is an ideal choice for the minimalist backpacker. Weighing just 410 grams (15 oz), it offers very light protection from nighttime insects, and can be set up with trekking poles or by suspending the ridgeline. It is designed to pair exactly with the Tarp 5, and the combo offers an impressively light warmweather shelter solution weighing only 730 g (1 lb 10 oz) in total.

### Windsack 2





Like the original three-person Windsack 3, the new two-person Windsack 2 is a lightweight, highly versatile winter backcountry essential. It's an emergency bivy bag that can be deployed as a temporary wind shelter, used as an improvised tarp, or laid out as a signal panel. The new Windsack 2 weighs 460 g (16 oz); the original Windsack 3 weighs 580 g (21 oz).

#### **New color choices**





Yellow Label, Blue Label models and Tarps get more color offerings. All Yellow Label tents will be available in Sand, as well as in Green and Red. Both the Blue Label Atlas and the Stalon XL will be available in Sand in addition to Green and Red. And all Tarp models will also be available in all three colors.

## **Reflective Cord (accessory)**





We have never been quite satisfied with the reflective lines that are available, so we designed our own, using our proprietary 3 mm Guy Line as a guide. Like our Guy Line, the Reflective Cord has "interwrap" construction, which interweaves remarkably strong Vectran fiber longitudinally with polyester, producing a cord with no sheath to slip, near zero stretch, minimal water absorption, an easy-to-handle soft feel, high UV resistance, and an impressive strength. The Reflective Cord adds a 1 mm reflective thread to the mix, and has the same 80 kg (176 lb) breaking strength as our 3 mm Guy Line. It is, however, heavier: where our regular 3 mm Guy Line weighs 133 g (4.7 oz) for 25 m, the Reflective Cord weighs 164 g (5.8 oz). The Reflective Cord is sold as an accessory in 25 m lengths.
